We believe we can win an election first time out, because the time is right. The electorate is totally disillusioned with all of the traditional parties, and the others are too one dimensional in outlook.

The different planks of our policies are all interlinked, for instance removing all recent immigrants, will remove the pressure on housing, keeping prices stable, as will building council houses, where they are needed. Raising the starting rate for stamp duty £350,000 will enable first time buyers to get on the housing ladder. Less population helps the environment. Less pressure on utilities, the N.H.S. etc. Helping the economy. Cutting taxes helps the economy, cutting crime will help the economy and so on.

The many changes will reduce the overheads needed to run the country, which will make everybody better off.

The national Institutions, Fire Services, Police, NHS, Post Office should be based on the needs of the public not accountants, or government. Efficient as well as proficient.

Below are some of our intended changes in order to achieve this. If elected we will carry out our policies, without fear or favour. We will put the Great back into Great Britain

## **MANIFESTO**

### **NATIONAL GOVERNMENT**

The four countries would be self governing, except for defence, currency, policing and immigration policies. Policies on these would have to be agreed unanimously. The four nations can be independent in their individual countries, but also united in Great Britain.

The following policies are for England only except for the aforementioned categories.

### **ECONOMY**

(1) The Bank of England would remain in charge of the bank rate. The steps taken to remove immigrants and force the unemployed to take the vacant jobs, not pay them to sit at home, along with reductions in the bloated bureaucracy, would release billions of pounds, to reduce general taxation significantly. The public spends their money far more wisely than any politician. We have other ideas to boost the economy, but have no intention of putting them in the public domain for now, for obvious reasons. Companies or individuals who wish to establish businesses will be welcome, but will be closely monitored to ensure their viability. Stamp duty starting point raised to £350,000.

## **IMMIGRATION**

(2) All immigrants, admitted since 2004, regardless of colour or creed will be sent back home to apply for job permits. Only twenty thousand, two year permits, to be issued per year. Asylum seekers will be sent to the nearest safe country to their country of origin. The immigration officers will be empowered to arrest any suspected illegal immigrant, and hold them until their status is confirmed. The borders to be properly policed. Criminals will be deported to their country of origin, on completion of sentence. Wanted criminals will be deported to the country requiring their return, providing the offence committed is also an offence in this country, regardless of that country's policy on capital punishment.

## **EMPLOYMENT**

(3) All school leavers to become apprentices, in the manual trades (mechanics plumbers etc.) this would start at sixteen.. Academic professions, nurses, doctors, lawyers etc.) to start at eighteen. The apprentices would do two days per week at college or university, three days paid work for their respective employers. All would be tied to their employers for three years after qualifying, to justify the cost of putting them through college or university. This would mean we would have a properly trained workforce, while the apprentices would finish up with their City and Guilds or Degrees with no debts at the end of the courses.

Youngsters who can't obtain paid employment within a specified time, would do two years national service. Where they would receive training in a job as well as serve their country.

People drawing dole would be expected to work two days a week creating cycle ways, or other public service work that isn't being done at present, in order to earn their dole.

People at present on invalidity would be tested for their suitability for work. Employers work be encouraged to find suitable for work the genuinely handicapped, most of whom would love to feel that they can contribute and earn their own money.

Young single mothers would be put into semi detached three bed roomed houses six to a house. One would be trained as a childminder, paid by the other three, the others would go out to work to earn the money needed to live. Single motherhood would not then be seen as a career option. This does not apply to divorcees or mothers from long term relationships. The father would be forced to help in the upkeep of the children etc.

Employment tribunals to be scrapped. An employment court established where complainants and defendants would put their own cases without solicitors present. This would cut the cost for both sides and give fair judgments.

## **EDUCATION**

(4) LEAs to be dissolved, headmasters to control expenditure. All areas would have Grammar, Secondary Modern and Comprehensive senior schools. If necessary initially on the same site. Grammar and Secondary modern parents would be allowed a free vote to have corporal punishment as a final resort, if all other options fail in their school. Comprehensives would employ members of STOPP and would not be given this option. Teachers must not bring politics into education. Truancy should be harshly punished

## **CRIME**

(5) Zero tolerance will become the norm, Double the number of prisons will be constructed to be finished inside a year. The prisoners could be trained and used to provide the necessary workforce, under the guidance of experienced tradesmen. No remission of sentences, any misbehavior would result in a longer sentence. A referendum on hanging to be called in the first year of office. Police to be deployed back on the streets and live within their patrol areas. Red tape to be minimised. The prosecution of offenders to be brought back under control of the police, The Crown Prosecution Service scrapped. Where a person injures himself in pursuance of crime or misbehavior no compensation is payable. Where community service is suggested, sorting of waste from dustbin collections, would be a perfect method of recycling and keeping the weekly bin collection. Foreign drivers resident in this country should have their cars, licences and insurances checked, and have to register if staying more than a month.

## **HOUSING**

(6) Council houses would be built to house the low paid, with priority given to residents of this country. Immigrants illegal or otherwise would not be given to these council houses. Nurses, Police and the Fire service will get subsidised accommodation during training. Planning will concentrate on individual developments, which would have to blend in with the area concerned. Large scale developments will be strictly limited, if allowed at all.

## **EUROPE**

(7) Extraction from the European Union will allow all these things to be implemented, including the rescinding of the human rights acts. We will trade with Europe and are happy to have easy links, but our borders must be well protected. Take back control of our surrounding waters, fishing rights etc. Human rights act to be scrapped, the traditional common laws to be reinstated. The Law Lords to be the ultimate court governing this country.

## **PARLIAMENT**

(8) The number of MPs to be reduced to 250. Lawyers not allowed to be MPs. As they are often the ones profiting from decisions made in parliament. All quangos to be dissolved. MPs to pay tax exactly the same as anyone else. Expenses to be strictly controlled. Local councilors to revert to non political status as soon as possible, expenses to be strictly controlled or scrapped.

## **HEALTH**

(9) The area health authorities to be dissolved, with close liaison with between doctors and hospitals instead. Targets to be abolished. Bureaucrats to be culled, cleaning to be controlled in house. Hospitals to specialise but must still have an accident and emergency unit. All large towns (20,000 people) to have accident and emergency services. Each county would have one or more specialist hospitals for the main problems, Heart disease, cancer etc.

## **FINANCE**

(10) Inheritance tax to be abolished. The tax on pension fund profits to be abolished. Income tax for state pensioners to be abolished. Standard rate Income tax to be progressively phased out and VAT increased to cover it. Existing exemptions in VAT to remain. Pensioners not to be charged VAT on heating fuel. High rate tax to reduce to 20% and start at £100,000. Road Fund licence to be scrapped, the increase in fuel tax. Will cover it. Private health insurance to be set against high rate tax. All stealth taxes to be looked at with a view to scrapping them.

## **ARMED FORCES**

(11) To be properly funded and equipped, and restricted to defence of the realm, or deployment within NATO, or the UN. Britain can only go to war with the full consent of parliament. Soldiers, sailors and airman, should be properly paid and housed.

The forces in Iraq and Afghanistan to return home promptly. No more deployments of that sort to be undertaken, unless all nations share full responsibility and cost.

## **RECREATION**

(12) The use of the outdoors to be encouraged for recreational purposes, for leisure, physical, and mechanical sporting activities. Where persons put themselves in danger, (rock climbing, racing motorbikes, cars, canoeing etc.) any injury resulting should be non compensationable, unless criminal negligence is proven. Any government money spent on recreation, should be targeted at the grass roots, not people seeking to be Olympic or World champions, as they are professionals and are funded by the lottery. More sporting and recreational facilities should be funded by the lottery, than individuals.

## **FISHING and FARMING**

(13) Coastal fishing limits to be reinstated. British owned ships only, no foreign owned vessels allowed. Set aside to be abolished. Imported food only to only be allowed in from countries that meet the same standards as the UK producers. To be rigorously enforced. Green fuel crops could be grown to aid in the rotation system and more than replace the subsidies currently in use. Although with the increase in food prices and shortage in food production, traditional crops would be probably take up the currently set aside land.

## **ENVIRONMENT**

(14) Cleaning up of rivers from pesticide and all other chemical residue to be concentrated on. Urban tree growth to be encouraged. Wind Farms to be scrapped. Weekly bin collections mandatory. Methane to be collected from land fill sites and used to run small electricity sub stations. Criminals will sort waste and sweep streets as part of their punishment.

Reservoirs to be constructed to collect water during high rainfall periods instead of it causing flooding or wastefully flowing out to sea. House construction on flood plains to be banned completely. Wood for construction or heating purposes only allowed to come from renewable sources.

No new motorways, but all A roads to be dual carriage ways and bypasses constructed to improve the town environment and keep traffic moving, so causing less pollution. Trees to planted alongside bypasses to absorb the pollutants.

## **FOREIGN POLICY**

(15) Great Britains' interest would be paramount in any decisions relating to foreign policy. A policy of reducing the world population to sustainable levels, to be campaigned for. No aid to be provided to countries who don't subscribe to this aim. Aid must only be supplied in practical terms by governments. Monetary aid is better raised and dealt with by the charity professionals.

## **GENERAL**

(16) Personal injury and discrimination claims to be settled in small claims court, solicitors can only offer advice not appear for either side. Unjustified claims would lead to heavy costs against the claimant.

BBC and all other news agencies to be kept under close watch, to ensure fair unbiased reporting, by an independent unpaid voluntary panel, drawn from across the political spectrum.
